

Worship On-Stage Wardrobe Guidelines for Men

- **Tops**
 - T-Shirts **ONLY if you add a layer on top** **see approved layering pieces below*
 - Crew necks only
 - Longer fit
 - No Graphic Shirts
 - No stains or smears, unintentional rips or holes
 - Preferably dark color
 - Long-Sleeve or Short-Sleeve Button Downs
 - Clothes should be freshly pressed or wrinkle free
 - White does well when layered **under** darker neutrals or earth tones
- **Pants**
 - Jeans: Well-fitting, preferably a dark wash or black, no white.
 - Slim-Fit or Straight leg, no wide-leg or bootcuts
 - No stains or smears, unintentional rips or holes
 - Slacks or Chinos
 - No athletic apparel, sweats of any kind, or items meant for working out or lounging
- **Layering Pieces**
 - Sport coat
 - Denim, Bomber, or Utility Jacket
 - Button Down Overshirt (no plaid overshirts)
 - Cardigan
 - Clothes should be seasonally appropriate, however layering even in the warmer months is recommended.
- **Shoes**
 - Oxfords & Wing-Tip dress shoes
 - Lace-Up Boot & Chelsea Boot
 - Very clean lifestyle sneakers (no athletic/gym shoes)
- **Overall Look**
 - Hair should be well kept, brushed, and facial hair well groomed
 - Face should be fresh and eyes clear
 - Black, gray, white and denim should be staple colors in your wardrobe choices
- **Camera Tips**
 - Neutral, dark, and earth tones look great on camera!
 - Prints that are too busy, too tight, or apparel with crazy logos don't do well on camera.
 - Bright white and red don't partner well on camera, no matter the lighting or your skin tone.

Simple Tips:

- The most important thing is for you to look professional. When in doubt bring a spare jacket with you in case.
