






Mission & Vision

Why BGroups?


- 1. Every individual deserves a family and BGroups exist to create a place to belong.

- Life Book Five lessons that help every person understand their new life in Christ.




Goal of BGroups (TWO)

- **A-Team** being part of a team.




Goal of BGroups (THREE)

"Therefore, go and make disciples" ~ Matthew 28:19


- Becoming a disciple who makes disciples of Christ.
- Learning how to live missionally.




The Flow of Leadership

Becoming a B-Group Leader

- 1. Complete all four weeks of Next Steps.
- 2. Attend B-Group Training.
- 3. Participate in a B-Group at least one semester.
- 4. Agree to comply with the B-Group leader commitment and honor code.



How to start your B-Group?

- Make your life your group...
 - What are you already doing that has people around you? Can you give that to God and use for His purpose?
- Turn your <u>existing</u> relationships, interests, passions, and hobbies into a <u>disciple-making</u> group.



How to Launch your Group

- 1. Choose the hub-type of group you will have, place to meet, and day/time that works best.
- 2. Register your B-Group.
- 3. Invite people to come to your group.
- 4. Pray & believe God is going to do great things through your group.



How to Lead a B-Group Meeting: What to Do . . .

- Connection become friends
- Conversation discuss the truth of God's word and hear people's heart (dialogue not monologue)
- Prayer/Ministry believe God together






