

# Christ Centered Joy

Message Handout

**Philippians 3:1 (NLT) - 1** Whatever happens, my dear brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord. I never get tired of telling you these things, and I do it to safeguard your faith.

**Philippians 3:2-3 (ESV) - 2** Look out for the dogs, look out for the evildoers, look out for those who mutilate the flesh. **3** For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh

## Paul gives us three places of joy:

#### 1. The joy of TRUSTING Christ

- Philippians 3:4–7 (NLT) 4 though I could have confidence in my own effort if anyone could. Indeed, if others have reason for confidence in their own efforts, I have even more! 5 I was circumcised when I was eight days old. I am a pure-blooded citizen of Israel and a member of the tribe of Benjamin—a real Hebrew if there ever was one! I was a member of the Pharisees, who demand the strictest obedience to the Jewish law. 6 I was so zealous that I harshly persecuted the church. And as for righteousness, I obeyed the law without fault. 7 I once thought these things were valuable, but now I consider them worthless because of what Christ has done.
- 2. Paul has perfect:
  - 1. PEDIGREE
  - 2. PREPARATION
  - 3. PASSION
  - 4. PERFORMANCE
- 3. Paul said that now these things are a total net loss. All humans are on a level playing field because of what Christ has done.
- 4. What's the point? There's joy when we trust in Jesus:
  - 1. For our righteousness
  - 2. For our acceptance
  - 3. For our lives today and tomorrow

### 2. The joy of KNOWING Christ

- 1. Philippians 3:8–11 (NLT) 8 Yes, everything else is worthless when compared with the infinite value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have discarded everything else, counting it all as garbage, so that I could gain Christ and become one with him. I no longer count on my own righteousness through obeying the law; rather, I become righteous through faith in Christ. For God's way of making us right with himself depends on faith. I want to know Christ and experience the mighty power that raised him from the dead. I want to suffer with him, sharing in his death, so that one way or another I will experience the resurrection from the dead!
- 2. Paul was going for one thing KNOWING JESUS.
- 3. John 17:3 (NLT) 3 And this is the way to have eternal life-to know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, the one you sent to earth.
- 4. Paul wanted to
  - 1. Gain Christ.
  - 2. Be one with Christ.
  - 3. Experience the power of Christ.
  - 4. Suffer with Christ.
  - 5. Share in the death of Christ.

#### 3. The joy of PURSUING Christ

- Philippians 3:12–14 (NLT) 12 I don't mean to say that I have already achieved these things or that I have already reached perfection. But I press on to possess that perfection for which Christ Jesus first possessed me. 13 No, dear brothers and sisters, I have not achieved it, but I focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead, 14 I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us.
- 2. Paul presses:
  - 1. To possess that perfection.
  - 2. To reach the end of the race.
  - 3. To receive the heavenly prize.
- 3. To do this, you have to cut ties with the past.
  - 1. Your merits
  - 2. Your failures
- 4. Christ is all in all; He's all that matters, knowing Him and becoming like Him.

**Philippians 3:20-21 (NLT) - 20** But we are citizens of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. And we are eagerly waiting for him to return as our Savior. **21** He will take our weak mortal bodies and change them into glorious bodies like his own, using the same power with which he will bring everything under his control.
