Spiritual

Psalm 37:3-5 (NLT) - Trust in the Lord and do good. Then you will live safely in the land and prosper. Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you your heart's desires. Commit everything you do to the Lord. Trust him, and he will help you.

1. Trust in the Lord and do good.

- 1. It doesn't matter what season of life you are in; you have to start with trust.
- 2. Even when you don't understand him, trust him.
- 3. Some of us trust the stock market more than we do the Lord.
- 4. The reason you are frustrated is because you have stopped trusting him. When You trust, You have peace.
- 2. **Take delight in the Lord.** This is the next step; once you trust him, you delight in Him. He is your priority; He is your desire!
- 3. **Commit everything you do to the Lord.** The last step is to commit your whole life to him—your heart, your mind, your finances, and your relationships!

4. Renew your mind

- Romans 12:2 says, "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind."
- 2. I believe there must be a renewal of the mind in this area. We have been inundated with so much from the world through movies, music, television, and conversations. We need a new perspective in this arena.

I. Mindset for Singles

We first need to establish the correct mindset when it comes to singleness.

- 2. Some people are embarrassed to be single.
- 3. Be secure in your singleness.
- 4. There is nothing wrong with being single. Some of the most significant people in the Bible were single.

- 1. Paul: A vocal advocate of singleness who considered it a gift from God
- 2. Anna: A prophet who was widowed and worshiped God daily
- 3. John the Baptist: Never married
- 4. Jeremiah: He said he sat alone because His hand was upon him.
- 5. Embrace the season you are in.
- 6. Go on adventures; do things on your bucket list. Build wealth; build yourself.
- 7. Solomon says there is a time and a season for everything under the sun.
- 8. No one will love you more than you love yourself. You must be comfortable with yourself first.

II. Mindsets for singles who are wanting to get married:

Here are some mindsets you should consider when it comes to dating.

Mindset # 1- Allow time for your mind to be renewed.

- 1. Too often, I see new converts jumping into relationships carrying old mindsets.
- 2. If you are not healthy, you will not find health
- 3. Dysfunction will always find dysfunction
- 4. All the world's mindsets regarding love and dating don't transfer over. They are not credits from college
 - 1. Whose you are matters.
 - 1. You are a child of the King.
 - 2. You are bought with a price.
 - 3. You are a royal priesthood.
 - 2. Begin to see yourself differently.

Mindset # 2- You are worth the wait

- 1. Don't let time discourage you. Remember your value.
