7 Statements of Worship

1. “SAVE ME” — Repentance

Psalm 51:7–10 NLT: “Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. Oh, give me back my joy again; you have broken me—now let me rejoice. Don’t keep looking at my sins. Remove the stain of my guilt. Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me.”

2. “THANK YOU” — Gratitude

Psalm 95:1–2 NLT: “Come, let us sing to the LORD! Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation. Let us come to him with thanksgiving. Let us sing psalms of praise to him.”

3. “I WILL PRAISE YOU” — Praise

Psalm 29:2 NIV: “Ascribe to the LORD the glory *due* his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of his holiness.”

Psalm 33:1 NLT: “Let the godly sing for joy to the LORD; it is *fitting* for the pure to praise him.”

4. “YOU ARE HOLY” — Honor

Psalm 25:14 ESV: “The friendship of the LORD is for those who fear him, and he makes known to them his covenant.”

Matthew 6:9 NLT: “Our Father in heaven, may your name be kept holy.”

5. “I NEED YOU” — Dependence

1 Peter 5:6 NLT: “So humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and at the right time he will lift you up in honor.”

6. “I LOVE YOU” — Affection

Matthew 22:37 NLT: “You must love the LORD your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.”

7. “I'M YOURS” — Surrender

Romans 12:1 NLT: “And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him.”
